It is the intention of Kane County Mutual Insurance Company to protect the privacy of our customers as required by law. It is our further intention that the information collected in the application or renewal process whether in person, by mail, telephone or electronically is to be used by appropriate employees of the company for the issuance of property insurance policies only. Our procedures for the use of insurance scoring are in compliance with Illinois state statutes. We do not sell any information to outside sources.

The information we collect on applications or other forms may include:

1. Name
2. Address
3. Social Security Number
4. Date of Birth
5. Telephone Number and/or E-mail address
6. Demographic information
7. Loss History
8. Employment
9. Mortgage Holders, Additional Insureds, or Other Interests
10. Credit Card Number with expiration date for premium payments

Collected information will be treated as confidential, with physical and procedural safeguards taken at the company office regarding access to and storage of this sensitive data. However, we will provide loss history information to another insurance carrier if requested. We will also confirm payment of premium to mortgagees and other lien holders if requested.

This privacy policy shall pertain to all current as well as former customers of Kane County Mutual Insurance Company.

Information gathered in the hiring process or during the term of employment of all current and past employees shall be treated with the same privacy considerations.

This includes members, past and present, of the Board of Directors.
